What play are you performing? *Macbeth*, by William Shakespeare

When are the performances?

Historic St. Mary's City State House Lawn; (Thursday, Friday, and Saturday) August 6, 7, and 8; (Thursday, Friday, and Saturday) 13, 14, & 15. All performances start at 7:30.

Three Notch Theater; (Thursday - Sunday) August 20 - August 23, 2026

Show times: Thursday 7:00 p.m., Friday and Saturday 8:00 p.m., Sunday 3:00 p.m.

There will be a sensory-friendly performance with ASL interpretation on Thursday, August 20, 2026 at 7:00 pm.

How long is the show? The show runs about 2 hours 30 minutes, with a 15-minute intermission

What is the age rating? It is PG-13

How much are tickets? The Friday and Saturday performances have the following ticket prices: \$20 for adults; \$17 for NTP Members and HSMC Members; \$17 for seniors, military, and students; \$15 for children 6 – 11; children 5 and younger are free.

When should I arrive?

- The gate opens at 6:30 p.m.

Where do I park?

- The State House parking lot off of Route 5.

Can I purchase food and/or alcoholic beverages on site?

- Yes, Angelika's Kitchen will be open until 7:15 p.m. before the show. You can either come early and dine-in or purchase food to go. There will be snack boxes available for sale.
- Non-alcoholic beverages will be available for purchase during intermission.

What if it rains?

- The show is rain or shine. In case of rain, the play will move underneath the open-air pavilion. Should there be lightning or a larger weather event, the show will be stopped for the safety of the performers and our guests)
