The Bridal Show at Historic St. Mary's City (HSMC)

Our Bridal Show on February 27, 2022 will be larger than ever before because we have the State House, tent and new pavilion. Our outreach to couples will go out to a larger geographical area.

How many couples do you expect to attend the Bridal Show?

• Previous Bridal Shows have had no less than 70 brides/couples in attendance.

Is there an inclement weather date?

• The inclement weather date is Sunday, March 13-same times and location.

What time do I need to arrive to set up?

• Vendor set up time: 9:00 a.m.-11:45 a.m.. A Continental breakfast and light lunch will be provided to the vendors on the second floor of the State House.

Where do I park to unload?

• Vendors should park in the State House parking lot to unload their car.

Do I need to move my car after unloading?

- Yes. All vendors will park in the HSMC overflow parking lot* (subject to change) after unloading and shuttled back to the Bridal Show via HSMC staff.
- Vendors will be shuttled back after the show to retrieve vehicles.

Will there be assistance to unload my vehicle?

- Volunteers will be on hand to help vendors unload their vehicle and transport their wares to their particular vendor location. You will be responsible for providing your own hand cart or wagon.
- HSMC will have roving Ambassadors during the show that can bring you bottled water or assist with other items.

What time does the Bridal Show begin?

- The Show begins at 12 p.m.
- Water will be provided by HSMC throughout the show.

Will I receive a list of those attending?

- Yes, a complete list of registered brides will be provided to the vendors prior to the show.
- A list of walk-in brides will be provided after the show.
- HSMC requests email addresses and phone numbers on their registration form.

What is your cancellation policy?

A full refund will be given if covid forces the Bridal Show to be canceled. We think this
will not be likely.

Is there a mask requirement?

- It will be strongly encouraged for everyone to wear a mask but not required at this time.
- HSMC will comply with all State regulations should there be any changes up to the day
 of the Bridal Show.

What time can I break down my booth?

Vendors cannot break down their booths until 4 p.m.
